OUR SCHOOLS

FOUNDATIONAL STAGE PRE-NURSERY, NURSERY, KG AND CLASSES I-II

The Foundational Stage incorporates all the principles of Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) and the curriculum framework of this stage is based on NEP 2020 which emphasizes the interrelated domains of holistic development through an integrated and play based approach focussing on development of life skills.

There is no formal examination. The children are evaluated continuously through activities conducted in the class in order to monitor their overall development. In classes I and II, children are evaluated on the basis of Formative and Summative Assessments.





PREPARATORY STAGE CLASSES III to V

The Preparatory Stage consists of Classes III to V. Although the curriculum for this stage is prescribed by the Council for the Indian School Certificated Examinations, we constantly update the methods, practices, and ideas that go into its delivery. Learning by doing and observing is encouraged at MCKV, which helps to realize the latent potential and talents of the tender minds, and converts them into active learners.

In Classes III to V also children are evaluated on the basis of Formative and Summative Assessments. Children at this stage also are also introduced to the idea of a formal examinations. Transition to the next class is determined on the basis of overall performance throughout the year in both the Academic and Non-Academic spheres

MIDDLE STAGE CLASSES VI TO VIII

Subjects taught: English, Mathematics, 2nd Language (Hindi/Bengali), Social Studies (History, Civics and Geography), Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology), Computer Studies, 3rd Language, General Knowledge, Moral Science, Art and Craft.

Middle Stage years are the pivot point between the Preparatory Stage and the secondary stage. The academic curriculum hence is designed to instil a healthy respect for hard work and to develop sound formal study skills. The students are prepared for the rigorous academic requirements of the secondary stage. The Middle Stage experience helps the students to gain confidence and push their boundaries of knowledge even further





SECONDARY STAGE CLASSES IX AND X

Subjects taught: English, Mathematics, 2nd Language (Hindi/Bengali), Social Studies (History, Civics and Geography), Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology), Computer Applications/Commercial Applications/Economic Applications.

In Secondary Stage, the scope of academic learning expands and gives students a wider perspective of education. At this stage, students are prepared for their first public examination, the Indian School Certificate Examination (CISCE), conducted by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations. Therefore, the emphasis is on academic rigour, diligence, consistency and regularity. Students also get the experience of working independently on projects related to their subjects, which, in turn, develops research skills in them

Classes XI and XII

Subjects taught: Science: English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Computer Science/Economics

Commerce: English, Mathematics/ Business Studies, Hindi/Bengali/ Physical Education, Commerce, Accounts, Economics/Computer Science

Humanities: English, Mathematics/History, Hindi/ Bengali/ Physical Education, Geography, Political Science.

At this stage, students are trained to learn independently, develop resilience and confidence, and become well-rounded individuals equipped with the 21st century skills needed to face the challenges of the outside world and become global citizens. At the end of Class XII, students take the Indian School Certificated (ISC) examination, conducted by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE).

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

MCKV believes that good teaching practices not only enhance communication between teachers and learners, but also provide learners an opportunity to apply their knowledge and skills in the practical world. Therefore, at MCKV, learning is no longer confined only to the classroom and laboratories, but is also linked with the world outside. Our pedagogical practices include activities that help children learn from experiences beyond the school. The rapidly changing world demands multi-dimensional pedagogies that help a child to become a well-rounded personality.




NURTURING EMPOWERED MINDS
