

The week-long 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav', organised all over the country to commemorate India's 75 years of independence from British rule, culminated at M. C. Kejriwal Vidyapeeth with an impressive programme comprising the flag-hoisting ceremony and a cultural programme at the school campus on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2022.

The day began with the hoisting of the national flag by our Chief Guest, Mr Rahul Roy, Inspector, Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs, and an alumnus of the school. The spirit of patriotism resonated across the campus when the National Anthem was sung compellingly by the gathering.

This was followed by two speeches: the first by our Director, Mr Neelkantha Gupta, who emphasized the core philosophy behind India's beauty of diversity; and the second by our School Captain, Hiten Golcha, who powerfully highlighted the role of the youth and their duty towards the nation. After this, the school choir presented a melodious rendition of Tagore's song 'Ekla Cholo Re', which set the tone for the rest of the programme.

An important feature of the day was the Prefects' Investiture Ceremony which included oath-taking by the newly appointed student leaders. Thereafter, our Chief Guest, Mr Rahul Roy, Director, Mr Neelkantha Gupta, Principal, Ms Mallika Mukherjee, and Headmaster, Mr Biswajit Majumdar draped the young leaders with a ceremonial sash bearing the badge of office and invested them with the authority to lead and steer the school in the right way.

The programme also featured striking mono-acting depicting two freedom fighters – Bhagat Singh and Ram Prasad Bismil, and the distribution of prizes to the winners of inter-house competitions.

The day came to an end with the felicitation of the Chief Guest, and a vote of thanks by Uday Kumar Bansal, the School Vice-Captain.


A panel discussion, held on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2022, for Class 11 students, was one of the events that took its cue from the broad theme. We had among us Professor (Dr) Ajit Kumar Chakraborty (born in 1940), former Professor of Metallurgy at IIT-Kharagpur, and Ms Gouri Qanungo (born in 1932), former Headmistress of Saradapalli Kanya Vidyapeeth, Bhadreshwar, Hooghly.

Prof. Chakraborty shared his memories of the first Independence Day celebrations in Dibrugarh on 15<sup>th</sup> August 1947, and the subsequent events surrounding the occasion. The daughter of a freedom fighter, Ms Qanungo, who at the time was in Class 10, shared heart-touching stories of her struggles as a student and eventual relocation to India from Chittagong in East Pakistan.

It was a privilege to hear the eminent guests share their first-hand experience of witnessing India's incredible journey from colonial subjugation to freedom. The amazing stories of a bygone era, which included Ms Qanungo's meetings with Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose and Mahatma Gandhi, held the audience spellbound, creating a magical aura in the auditorium.

The hour-long panel discussion was skilfully moderated by our Director, Mr Neelkantha Gupta. The programme ended with our Chairman, Mr Kishan Kumar Kejriwal felicitating the guests.

For the Class 11 students, it was phenomenal to experience the story of India's Independence come alive through personal narratives and anecdotes.

## Aadipto Bose Class 12A








#### Whiz-kid

#### **Proverb Puzzle**






