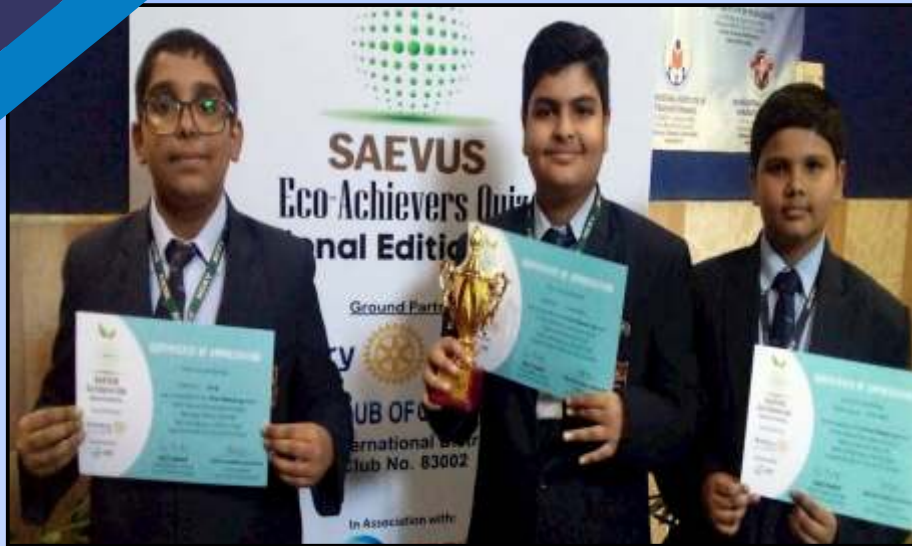
Summary of School Events

MCKV GraphoInsight: Mastering the art of handwriting analysis
